



Help with your 4 legged kid!

WHAT TO BRING

Meals

Provide enough food and/or daily supplements (medications) for your dog's stay. Provide written instructions **on the food bag (or inside the travel bag)**, along w/ proper measurement cups. Do NOT provide food or water bowls. Please do not provide anything ceramic or breakable.

Chewing / Enrichment / Toys

Make sure to pack enough chew items AND toys for your dog.

Make sure to pack appropriate (long-lasting) chew items (like bully sticks or Himalayan chews) or mental stimulation items (like stuffed kongs) for your dog. You provide the ingredients for any frozen kongs and we will prepare the kongs.

Bedding – You may provide a dog bed from house or bedding from crate.

Grooming

Please make sure that your dog is clean (bathed) prior to the boarding appointment. Although the backyard is grass, the surrounding property is dirt and sand, dogs may get dirty during play.

It is highly recommended that your dog be groomed (especially poodles or doodles - cut short) prior to boarding to ensure that their fur does not get matted causing them to be uncomfortable.

If your dog will require grooming during their stay, please make arrangements. There is an extra cost for me to drop off and pick up your dog at the groomer.

Collar / ID tag

Make sure that your dog's collar is properly fitted. The collar should NOT be able to come off simply by bringing it over the dog's neck. Please make sure that your dog's collar is SECURE. Current ID tags should also be on the collar with current phone number. Make sure your dog is microchipped. Another layer of safety is a GPS Collar. If you chose the FI dog collar (that's what I use with my dogs), use this code to get \$20 off at activation https://shop.tryfi.com/r/52MH7F/?utm_source=referrals

Flea / Tick - Please make sure dog is current on all flea and/or tick medications.

Vaccinations

Dog MUST BE current on all vaccinations and provide **proof PRIOR to boarding**.

Required vaccinations are Rabies, Bordatella and DHPP.

Confinement

Your dog **must be comfortable with confinement** either inside a crate (with door closed) during night time sleep and/or inside an exercise pen or covered play pen area for a few hours during the day. Whining and/or barking must be minimum. If dog is not comfortable with confinement, then boarding is not the right fit.

Other - If possible, try to fit everything in only 1-2 bags.

Each time the dog is boarded, an **updated boarding payment doc must be signed**.

This service is not recommended for dogs that have aggression or separation anxiety issues (or engage in excessive whining or barking). If you do not disclose aggressive or anxious behavior that results in any type of destruction or noise issue, you will be responsible for the cost of housing your dog at an alternate location for safety or noise concerns.
